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Activity One:

1. How many pieces of music are played in this concert?
2. By each of the words below, write the name of the piece of music that sounded the most like that word to you:
 - a. Gentle
 - b. Scratchy
 - c. Mysterious
 - d. Energetic
 - e. Dramatic
3. What was your favourite piece of music in this concert?
4. Write 3 words that describe how that piece make you feel? You can use some of the words below if you like, or come up with your own.
 - a. Happy, sad, joyful, energetic, sleepy, grumpy, sensitive, alive, like dancing or running or jumping, like being underwater, like being on an aeroplane, excited.

Activity Two:

1. How many performers are there in this concert?
2. Name 3 different instruments that were played during the concert.
3. Which performer played two instruments in this concert?
4. What were the instruments that he played?
5. What instrument played in the concert best matches the following descriptions:
 - a. Long, silver, played by blowing
 - b. Large, on wheels, played by plucking the strings
 - c. Brown, rested under your cheek, played with a bow
